## Genesis 6:9

**NIV** <sup>9</sup>This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God.

**HCSB** <sup>9</sup>These are the family records of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among his contemporaries; Noah walked with God. (\*Holman Christian Standard Bible)

**ESV** <sup>9</sup>These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.

YOUR TRANSLATION: these are the generations of Noah.
