Genesis 25:20

NIV <sup>20</sup> and Isaac was forty years old when he married Rebekah daughter of Bethuel the Aramean from Paddan Aram and sister of Laban the Aramean.

NASB <sup>20</sup> and Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah, the daughter of Bethuel the Aramean of Paddan-aram, the sister of Laban the Aramean, to be his wife.

NKJV <sup>20</sup> Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian.

YOUR TRANSLATION: And Isaac was forty years old when he married  
Rebekah daughter of Bethuel the Aramean from Paddan-Aram  
and the sister of Laban the Aramean.
