4.01 supplement Introduce the last letters of aleph-bet plus another vowel

Letters (aka consonants) & Vowels (aka nikkudot וָקַדּוֹת)

Please note: there are 2 forms of the **3**).

The 1st is \triangleright (pay, which has a dot) while the 2nd is \triangleright (fay, which has no dot). (There is also the fay sofit \triangleright which has the same sound as the fay \triangleright).
