

Messianic Erev Shabbat Blessings



... call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable,
Isaiah 58:13, ESV

1. Messianic Blessing of the Shabbat & Festival candlelight:

No later than 18 minutes before sunset and prior to sitting down for the Erev Shabbat (Friday night) dinner, the mother and daughter light the candles and pray:



בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ
בְּמִצְוֹתָיו, וְנָתַתָּ לָנוּ אֶת יֵשׁוּעַ מְשִׁיחֵנוּ אֹר הָעוֹלָם: אָמֵן

Baruch atta YHVH, Elohaynu melech ha-olam, asher ked-deshanu
baymetztvotav vaynatanlanu et Yeshua meshechaynu or ha-olam. (Amen)

Blessed are You, YHVH our God, King of the universe, who makes us holy with His commandments, and Who gave to us Yeshua (Jesus) our Messiah, the Light of the world. (Amen)

2. Blessing of the wine (grape juice):

The father (or head of house) lifts the cup and prays:



בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם בּוֹרֵא פְּרֵי הַגֶּפֶן: אָמֵן

Baruch atta YHVH, Elohaynu melech ha-holam, boray pree ha-gafen. (Amen)

Blessed are You, YHVH our God, King of the universe, who creates the fruit of the vine. (Amen)

3. Blessing of the bread:

The father (or head of house) lifts the bread and prays:



בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם הַמוֹצִיא לֶחֶם מִן
הָאָרֶץ: אָמֵן

Baruch atta YHVH, Elohaynu melech ha-olam, ham-motzee lechem meen ha-aretz.
(Amen)

Blessed are You, YHVH our God, King of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth. (Amen)
