- #3 Blue tint illustrates Shabbat (which begins on Friday & ends Saturday at sundown). ALSO both the beginning of Festival (erev Festival) & the Shabbaton (holy day for Festival).
- #4 “You shall take ...the fruit [etrog], of splendid trees, branches of [lulav] palm trees & boughs of leafy trees & willows of the brook & rejoice before YHVH 7 days” Lev 23:40
